The Department of Philosophy and Sociology of DNURT invites you to take part in the 6th annual International Scientific Conference "**Anthropological Measurements of Philosophical Research**" (Chairman of the Scientific Committee – Khmil V. V., Ph.D., Professor, Head of the Department "Philosophy and Sociology").

The Conference will be held on April 13-14, 2017 at the Dnipropetrovsk National University of Railway Transport named after Academician V. Lazaryan (DIIT). The main task of the Conference is to discuss the anthropological aspects of science and technology, the problems of man and human subjectivity in cultural and historical-philosophical reflection.

Focus areas of the Conference:

1. Anthropological aspect of philosophy of technology and philosophy of science:
 - instrumental, ontological and humanistic understanding of technology;
 - alluring prospects and hidden threats of technology;
 - the problem of truth: science, philosophy, religion.
2. Philosophical problems of language:
 - the anthropological intentions of European philosophy and "turn to the language";
 - analytical philosophy of language.
3. Historical and philosophical reflection in the Post-Modernism era:
 - Post-Modernism: completion or continuation of the modern?
 - the problem of man in the philosophy of Post-Modernism.
4. Phenomenon of human subjectivity in the context of gender studies.

Experts in the field of philosophy, sociology and other social and human sciences, as well as postgraduate students and applicants who intend to carry out approbation of their scientific research are invited to participate in the Conference.

The Organizing Committee plans both full-time and remote participation in the Conference. Regulation: reports - up to 15 minutes, performances - up to 7 minutes. Conference languages: Ukrainian, Russian, English.

It is supposed to be held the sections and round tables on this issue, and participation in a videoconference (Skype) is planned. Selection of those wishing for remote participation will be carried out by organizers of the Conference according to the relevance of the submitted materials.

The deadline for submitting the texts of the reports is **March 27, 2017**. The Organizing Committee will confirm the receipt of the material by e-mail.

Registration fee is 130 UAH (by personal attendance). In case of remote participation using Skype the fee is 100 UAH. Doctors of Philosophical Sciences and Professors are exempt from payment of registration fee.

One can get the Conference proceedings in hard copy for the participants of the full-time and remote form of the Conference upon preliminary order and payment of 50 UAH for one copy.

In case of absentia form of participation, the fee for printing the theses and obtaining a paper copy is 120 UAH.

Requisites for payment will be sent by e-mail after receipt of your materials by the Organizing Committee.

Mandatory requirement: Fill in the application form for participation in the Conference, send the report materials (topic: "Conference on Philosophy"); pay the registration fee.

1. Requirements for the volume of publications:

- texts of reports: from 2 to 5 pages;

2. Rules for the text layout:

The texts should not contain hard returns.

Materials should be sent in the format Microsoft Word (version up to 2010 inclusive). The material is provided in A4 format; Times New Roman; font size - 14. line interval - 1.5; paragraph indentation - 1.25 cm.

Note that all data are in three languages (Ukrainian, Russian, English):

The title is typed in capital letters with an alignment in the middle. The next line indicates information about the author: surname, initials, below - the place of work or study. Abstracts (two or three sentences) and keywords (two or four words) are mandatory.

Bibliographic references are made in the text. The text should contain bibliography.
